## First year Summary Report of Lebanese University Activities in the Project

- 1- Participation in the kick-off meeting held in Cairo.
- 2- Conducting a survey in north Lebanon hospitals In order to study the implementation of e-health in Lebanon and its impact on the community in general and on the relationship between patients and physicians. In this study, we have chosen a sample of 14 main hospitals in north Lebanon (which represent around 50 percent of the total of healthcare institutions), including 13 private and one public hospitals.
- 3- Meeting with the coordinator of the e-health program in the Ministry of Public Health to know what are the achievements of the e-health project at the ministry and how can we cooperate in this field.
- 4- Meeting with the doctors of the Health Directorate in North Lebanon to discuss the cooperation between the Lebanese University and the Regional Health directorate in the field of e-health.
- 5- Meeting with the President and the Scientific Committee of the Order of Physicians in Tripoli to discuss the implementation of e-health in Lebanese healthcare institutions in north Lebanon and the future cooperation especially in the training of medical doctors in the Order.
- 6- Meeting with the CEO of Tripoli Governmental Hospital (The biggest in north Lebanon) to study the possibility of the hospital hosting the implementation of some e-health applications in cooperation with the Lebanese University.
- 7- Meeting with the Representative of the World Health Organization in Lebanon to discuss the financial support of the international organization in the implementation of the e-health project in Tripoli Governmental Hospital.
- 8- Participation in the webinar on e-health in Estonia done by TALC University.
